Remark: 1. According to Battery Regulation (EU) 2023/1542:

(1) Without prejudice to directive 2000/53/EC, Member States shall prohibit the placing on the market of:

(a) *From 18 August 2024, portable batteries, whether or not incorporated into appliances, that contain more than 0.01% (100mg/kg) of lead by weight;

(b) portable batteries, whether or not incorporated into appliances, light means of transport or other vehicles, that contain more than 0.002% (20mg/kg) of cadmium by weight;

(c) batteries, whether or not incorporated into appliances, light means of transport or other vehicles, that contain more than 0.0005% (5mg/kg) of mercury by weight.

(2) The prohibition set out in paragraph (1) (a) shall not apply to portable zinc-air button cells until 18 August 2028.

2. According to Article 5 of Article 13 of Chapter III of the Battery Regulation (EU) 2023/1542, all batteries containing more than 20 mg/kg cadmium or more than 40 mg/kg lead, shall be marked with the chemical symbol for the metal concerned: Cd or Pb. In addition, the relevant chemical symbol indicating the heavy metal content shall be printed beneath the separate collection symbol and shall cover an area of at least one-quarter the size of that symbol.

3. Results shown are of total weight of the battery sample.

4. ^All batteries containing more than 0.002% cadmium or more than 0.004% lead, shall be marked with the chemical symbol for the metal concerned: Cd or Pb

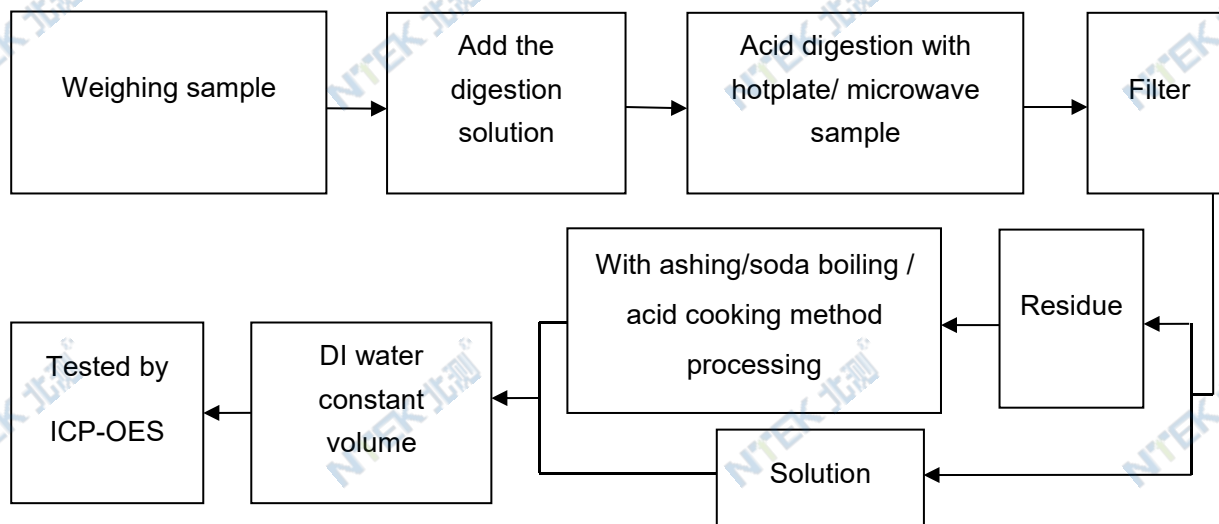

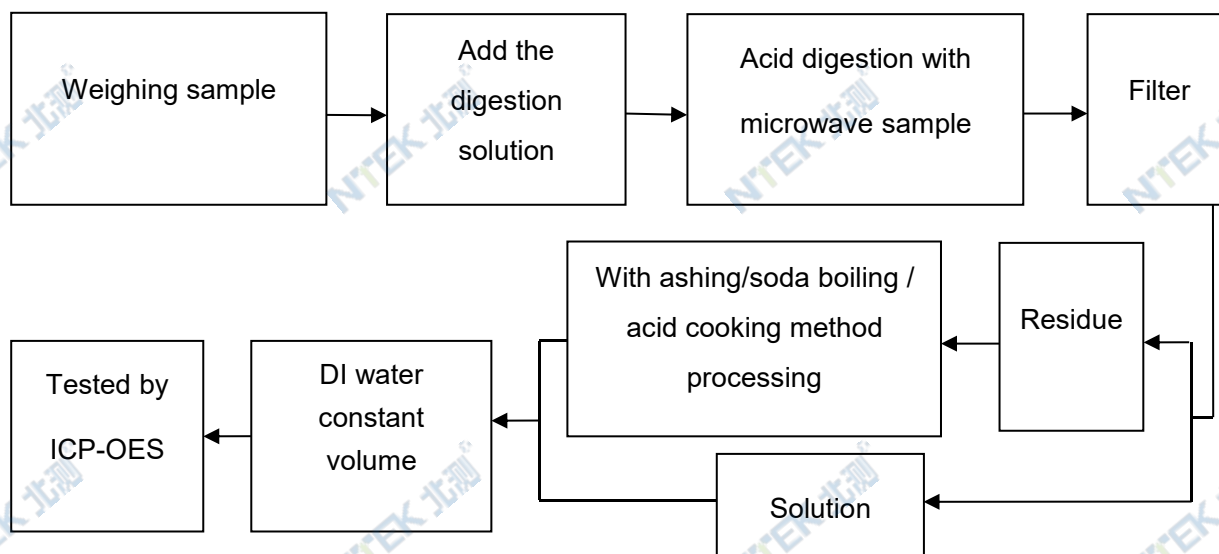

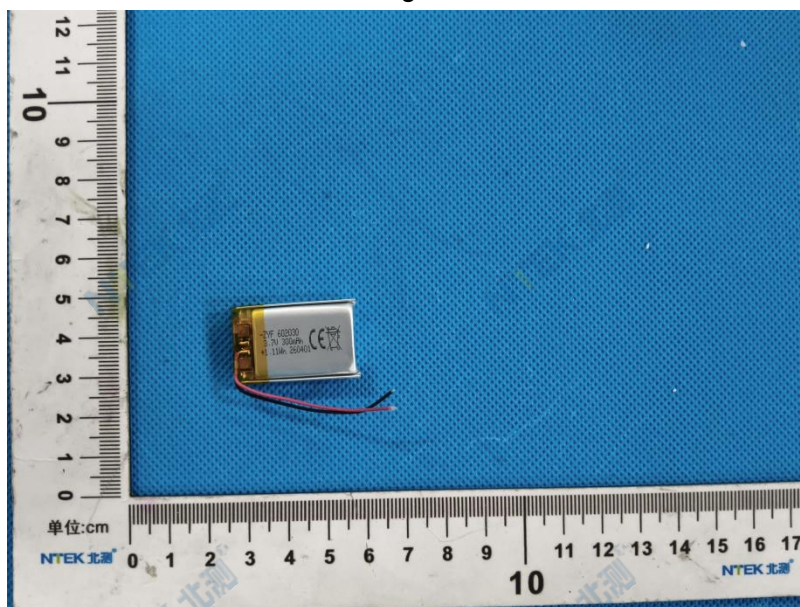
